Author information

Please include the author's name, education, position, institution and e-mail address at the beginning of the manuscript.

Editing

Manuscripts should be typed in Word format, Times New Roman font, with double-spacing and 12-point font.

Abstract

For studies, please provide an abstract of 5-8 lines at the beginning of the text. Please highlight keywords at the end of the abstract.

Figures, graphs and photos

Authors are requested to prepare figures and graphs in such a way that they can be interpreted in black and white print. Please also attach the tables/numerical data on which the graphs are based in a separate Excel file. Figures and photographs should also be supplied in a separate file (tif or jpg format) with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. When scaling the figures and tables and the amount of text in the tables, please take into account the dimensions of the page size (width: 130 x height: 200 mm). Figures and tables larger than this should be reduced in size, but only to the extent that this does not impair the legibility of the text.

References in the text

Please use in-text references. Footnotes should only include a reference to the published text if absolutely necessary.

Examples of in-text references

In single-authored works: (ŠOTOLOVÁ 2000); (JANOŠKO 2011); "It is also closely related to prophetic expression." (TARJÁNYI 1992: 14.)

For two- or three-author works: (KALMÁR-NAGY 2012); (LLOYD-KING-CHENOWETH 2002); LLOYD, KING and CHENOWETH (2002)

In the case of more than three authors at first occurrence: (FREISINGER-GYARMATI-RÁCZ-SZOMBATHELYI 2015), hereafter: (FREISINGER et al. 2015)

Bibliography

At the end of the manuscript, all references are listed in alphabetical order. Please use the following format for the title citations:

HAAG, HERBERT DR. (1989, ed.): *Bibliai Lexikon*. The Holy Apostolic See Book Publishing House, Budapest.

Internet links

Studies and journals found on the Internet are listed in the bibliography in the usual way, indicating the author, year and place, and the date of consultation at the end of the title. E.g.
